

# Generative Artificial Intelligence and Storytelling: How to Effectively Use the Tools for Authentic Human Connection

1. How to “Contain” an interaction (storytelling).
  - a. Be clear on why you are engaging and what you want to find out.
  - b. Who will be a part of this interaction?
  - c. When and how long will the storytelling event be?
2. Introduction to Story Listening
  - a. Narrow Listening is focused on the content.
  - b. Wide Listening takes in the periphery.
  - c. Dense Listening attends to the storyteller’s body and energy.
  - d. Emergent Listening waits for something new.
3. How to use Open Response and Restorative Dialogue
  - a. A dialogue is “thinking through” something, and working together.
  - b. Restorative Dialogue is speaking and listening in all four directions: narrow, wide, dense, and emergent.
  - c. This kind of dialogue wanders and waits for revelation.
4. Storytelling is a primary tool when working with Generative AI.
  - a. Restorative Dialogue will yield more useful prompts.
  - b. Storytelling will support more satisfying interactions with AI.
